- Performed vasectomy in lions and monkeys. Developed three finger palpation technique for vasectomy in deer.



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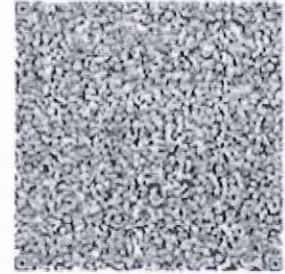
